Cross-Border Terminal



Cross-Border Terminal:

- The Cross-Border Terminal is a 525 foot long pedestrian bridge spanning the U.S.-Mexico Border and connecting passengers directly to the Tijuana International Airport.
- Annually nearly 4.5 million travelers fly out of the Tijuana International Airport. An average of over 6000 passengers cross the border daily to use the airport.
- The innovative Cross-Border Terminal will be the first of its kind in North and South American

- Today, Brown Field is a busy general aviation airport, with room to expand both physically and economically.
- Plans for phased construction at Brown Field are projected to create 4,000 permanent jobs and contribute more than \$500 million annually to the local economy.

The Future:

- \$900 million dollars in upgrades are planned for Brown Field over the next 20 years. 331 acres will be developed, resulting in over 100,000 square feet of additional aircraft facilities, including 55 new hangars and commercial space.
- The \$78 million dollar Cross-Border Terminal is expected to open in late 2015. It is projected to transport over 1.5 million passengers in its first year alone and will grow to encompass both commercial space and lodging.
